



- Requirement for completion
- (1) Successful completion of the full 4-year program at APU and SEU.
- (2) Successful completion of the minimum required credits to be awarded degrees by APU (124) and SEU (120).
- (3) Successful completion of Capstone Course at SEU or Undergraduate Thesis at APU (transferred as Capstone Course at SEU). Students may complete both as well!

Tuition payment

Because this is the program with APU's partner universities, there is <u>no</u> <u>need to pay</u> the Host University any tuition costs; instead you simply keep paying your regular APU tuition while on the program.

If you have tuition reduction plan from APU,

Tuition reduction will remain in effect even when you are studying abroad (given that you pass the assessment every semester.)
