

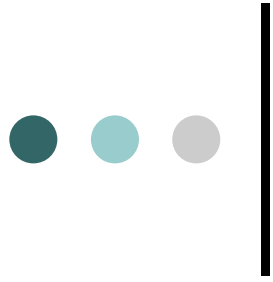

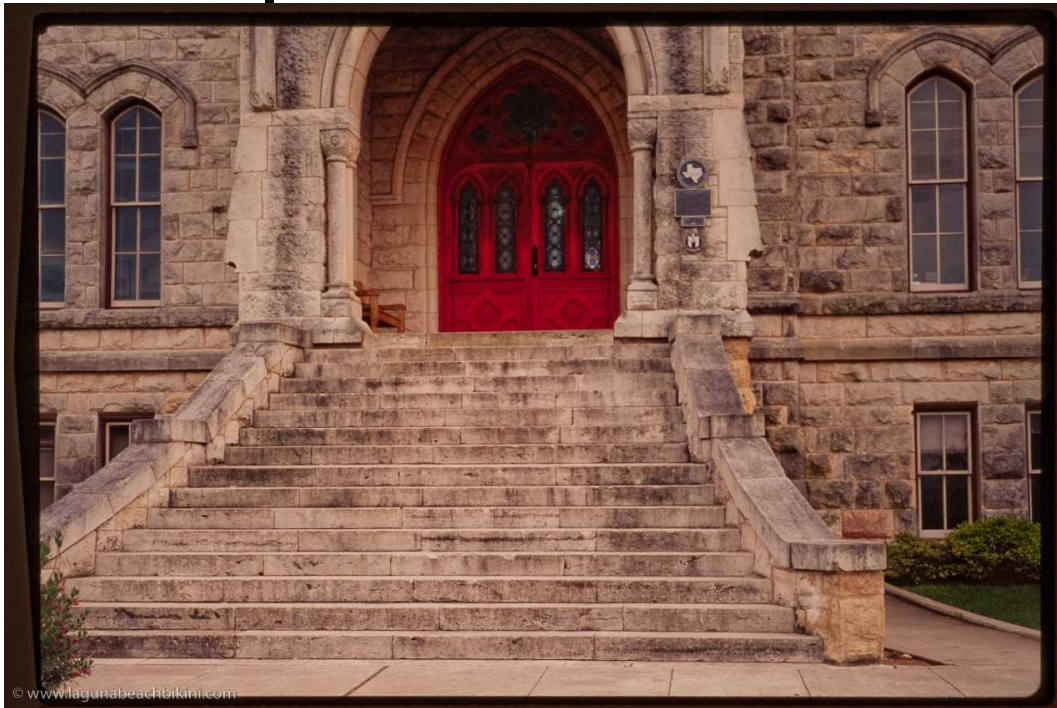

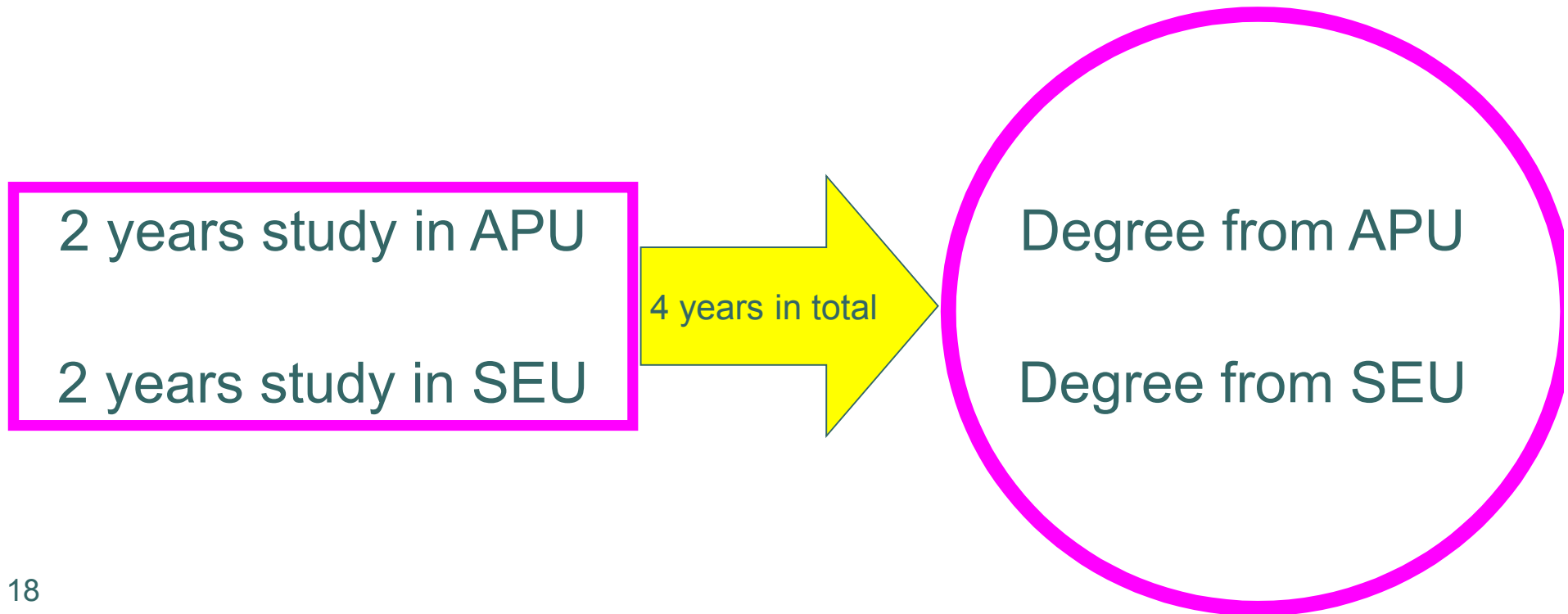

What is Undergraduate Dual Degree Program?

- ▶ Degrees you can receive from respective university

【APS students】

APU ⇒ Bachelor of Social Science

SEU ⇒ Bachelor of Arts



What is Undergraduate Dual Degree Program?

▶ How to spend 4 years in this program

	Credits at APU	Credits at SEU
2017FA – 2018SP 1 st year at APU (1~2 semester)	36 Credits (Maximum)	30 credits Credit Transfer
2018FA – 2019SP 2 nd year at SEU (3~4 semester)	Credit Transfer (60 credits Maximum)	30 credits
2019FA – 2020SP 3 rd year at SEU (return to APU from 2 nd Quarter of 2020SP) (5~6 semester)		30 credits
2020FA – 2021SP 4 th year at APU (7~8 semester)	48 Credits (Maximum)	30 credits Credit Transfer
Required number of credits for completion	124 Credits	120 Credits



General Education Requirements for all students

Students will work with a Global Studies advisor at SEU when registering for courses

What is Undergraduate Dual Degree Program?



Requirement for completion

- (1) Successful completion of the full 4-year program at APU and SEU.
- (2) Successful completion of the minimum required credits to be awarded degrees by APU (124) and SEU (120).
- (3) Successful completion of Capstone Course at SEU or Undergraduate Thesis at APU (transferred as Capstone Course at SEU). Students may complete both as well!



What is Undergraduate Dual Degree Program?



Tuition payment

Because this is the program with APU's partner universities, there is no need to pay the Host University any tuition costs; instead you simply keep paying your regular APU tuition while on the program.



If you have tuition reduction plan from APU,

Tuition reduction **will remain** in effect even when you are studying abroad (given that you pass the assessment every semester.)

※Ask the Student Office in details.



What is Undergraduate Dual Degree Program?

▶ Living Expenses

Approx. 1,100,000 ~ 1,500,000 yen annually
(excluding APU tuition fee)

※ Dormitory rent approx. \$3,000 ~ \$4,000
/semester (dormitory availability not guaranteed)



How to apply for the Dual Degree Program?

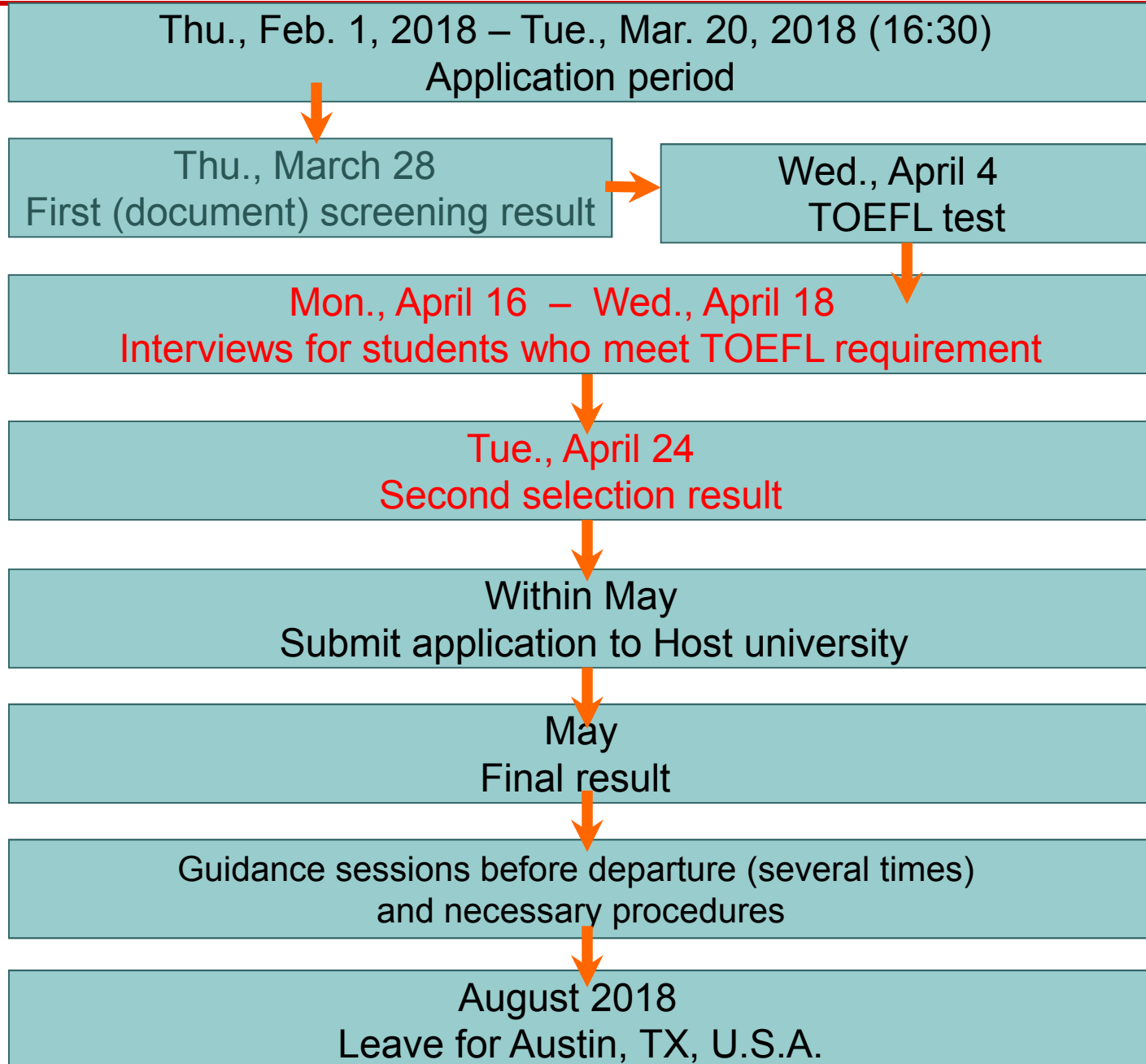
▶ Eligibility

Semester	The 1 st semester students only (as of 2017 Fall)
College	APS
Domestic/International	Both are eligible.
Cumulative GPA	3.00 or higher at end of 1 st year at APU *GPA of 1 st semester must be 3.00 or higher at the time of screening.
Language standard	【At time of application】 TOEFL ITP 525; TOEFL iBT 71; IELTS 5.5 TOEIC 700; Eiken Grade Pre-1 【At time of departure】 TOEFL ITP 550; TOEFL iBT 79
Others	Advised to complete all mandatory language subjects in the first year.
