③ Teaching Methods	This course use "Linguistic field method". Students will get the basic knowledge and practice language in classroom with teachers and informants, and study outside of class in real environment of Thai. Students will use the Thai language skills and knowledge that they acquired from classroom to learn more vocabularies or sentences on another events. They have to transcribe/ drawing/ taking a photo and make a short note by themselves.
