Recommended Qualifications / Knowledge	<p>【Application Requirements】 1) Students motivated to study Vietnamese language, including students who have no basic skills in Vietnamese and students who are currently enrolled in or have completed (or have been exempted from) Vietnamese subjects at APU. 2) Students whose native language is not Vietnamese</p>
	<p>【Class Structure】 Students will take part in an intensive short-term Vietnamese program offered by the University of Social Sciences and Humanities - VNU Ho Chi Minh City. Students will be divided into classes that are suitable to their Vietnamese level. These are classes exclusively for APU students. In addition to class time, students will also work with language partners, who are Vietnamese students, to practice the Vietnamese language they learn in class. Moreover, students will also learn about some aspects of Vietnamese history and culture, and take part in some extra-curricular activities.</p>
Course Overview	<p>【Course Overview】 This course was specially designed for APU students. It emphasizes practical oral and written Vietnamese language through dialogues, listening comprehension exercises, sentence pattern drills, and grammar exercises. The course gives students basic language skills for everyday living, including carrying on simple conversations that relate to common everyday topics such as houses and room renting, hobbies and habits, occupations, leisure activities, and describing personal characteristics. Local excursions and field trips reinforce the language exercises.</p>
	<p>【Program Contents】 The program includes pre-program classes before going to the host city, a post-program session after returning to Japan, Vietnamese language classes in the host university, and other extra-curricular activities in the host city.</p>
	<p>【About the City: Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam】 Ho Chi Minh City, also known as "Sài Gòn", is the most energetic city in Vietnam, where people from all over Vietnam come to live, study, and do business. The name "Sài Gòn" dated back to the end of 17th century, around 330 years ago. As one of the main cities in Vietnam, Ho Chi Minh City is rich in history and culture. Currently, there are around 13 million people live in Ho Chi Minh City. Ho Chi Minh City is one of the biggest transportation hubs and economic centers in Vietnam (together with Hanoi), attracts many foreign people come for travelling and working also. Tourists coming to Ho Chi Minh City can enjoy many interesting activities, delicious foods from different regions of Vietnam, and find out about various aspects of Vietnamese culture. With its energetic nature, Ho Chi Minh City will continue to develop as an economic, tourist, and cultural center of Vietnam.</p>
Course Objectives	The objective of the course is to improve Vietnamese language skill of students who participating in the program. Students are expected to complete at least one level of Vietnamese language. The course also aims to introduce to students different topics of Vietnamese culture, history, and daily life in Ho Chi Minh City.
