到達目標 Course Objectives	The objectives of this course are as follows:  1)Strengthen practical English skills in order to live and study in an English-speaking culture;  2)Develop an understanding of the cultures and societies of English-speaking regions;  3)Develop an interest in and awareness of the English and academic skills that are needed for further study abroad (e.g. student exchange).
授業方法 Teaching Methods	A variety of teaching methods will be used in this course, including:  Teacher-directed and student-directed pair and group work as part of the English language program at an overseas university;  Teacher-directed reflection activities as part of the post-program lecture after returning to APU.
毎回の授業の概要 Overview of Each Class	Overseas component: Class objectives and contents will vary by institution. As a general rule, students are required to complete a 3-5 week, 4-skill general communication or academic English language course at a designated university overseas for a minimum of 60 instructional hours during the APU spring vacation, in order to receive credit for this course.  APU component: Students will be required to attend one or more pre-departure guidance sessions at APU concerning risk management guidance, procedures for health insurance, etc. A post-program lecture will be held at APU to check achievement and to form a post-program study plan. The Pearson Progress Test will be held during the post-program lecture to assess students' English language proficiency. 多文化協働学修の実践方法 Method of Implementing Multicultural Collaborative Learning	During this course, students will be exposed to the culture, society and lifestyle of people in the destination country on a daily basis. Furthermore, they will also be exposed to a wide variety of cultural perspectives by interacting with teachers and students in the English language course at the host university. They will need to use English to interact and collaborate with people from different cultures and backgrounds to complete a variety of tasks in this context.

学生への要望事項 Requirements for Students	At all times: APU students are expected to be on time and to respect the class rules at the host university and the rules, customs and laws of the local society. Students should keep in mind that they are representatives of APU and should conduct themselves properly at all times.  Participation Students are expected to participate actively in all class activities when overseas in order to speed up their language learning and get the most of out of their lessons.  Attendance Students are expected to be on time and to attend all classes at the host university. Students who are recorded as absent for 25% or more of classes at the host university without valid reasons, may not be awarded credit for this course.  Responsibility of absent students: Students who are absent from class are expected to contact their teacher at the host university to explain their absence and to find out about work done or assigned during their absence.  Language Policy: APU students may find other Japanese students along with other non-native speakers in their English class at the overseas university. When faced with this situation, APU students should make their best effort to use English to communicate with their classmates, in order to speed up their language learning. Needless to say, students should use English as much as possible outside of class time to complete daily tasks and learn about the local people and culture.
