1. プログラム概要

本ダブルディグリープログラムは、APU とアメリカのセントエドワーズ大学 (St. Edward's University、以下 SEU) の学生が、各大学で2年間ずつ学修を行うことで、計4年間で両大学の学位を取得することを可能にするプログラムです。

4年間で2つの学位を取得することは容易ではありません。そのため、APU で履修する科目が SEU の単位や卒業要件に該当するか、また SEU で履修する科目が APS の単位や卒業要件を満たすかを慎重に確認することが重要です。これらを考慮せずに履修を進めると、2 つの学位の取得が困難になるだけでなく、卒業の遅延につながる可能性があります。両大学のカリキュラムを十分に理解し、計画的に履修を進めることが、DUDP プログラム参加者として求められる重要な姿勢です。

学生は SEU の行動社会科学部グローバル・スタディーズ学科 (BSS) で学び、プログラム修了後、以下の学士号を取得します。

選考方法

選考は、学業成績、申請書類、語学運用能力、学修計画、英語で行われる面接などの結果に基づいて、 総合的に判断します。

選考基準

- 外国の大学で勉強生活を送るにふさわしい英語運用能力を有していること。
- 学内選考の際、申請時の言語条件を満たしていること。

面接(書類審査合格者のみ実施)

- 明確な学修計画や到達目標があること。
- 派遣国社会に溶け込むのに必要な適応性があり、自らの力で留学生活における困難を乗り 越える力と、それに対処する気質を有していること。
- 高度な英語運用能力を有していること。

重要事項

• 原則として、派遣決定後の辞退はできません。

4. 申請方法

<u>Off-campus Study Programs のウェブサイト</u>のプログラム概要と以下の手続きをよく読んで、オンライン申請及びメールで行ってください。書類不備があった場合は、申請を受け付けません。

ステップ I

- 1) オンライン申請(英語のみ)
- オンライン申請は英語で回答してください。
- 指定されている項目に記入がない場合、極端に文字数が足りない場合は選考を行いません。
- オンライン申請では、提出ボタンを押す前に、「自分の回答についての確認メールで受け取る」をクリックし、申請内容を保管しておいてください。また、ご自身の申請内容は、「印刷または PDF で保存する」をクリックし保存する事ができます。

- 複数回申請を行った場合は、申請日が新しいもののみを受け付けます。
- 2) 経費支弁書の署名 (Adobe 電子署名)

申請者および経費支弁者の両方が電子署名をする必要があります。まず、申請者が必要事項を入力後、経費支弁者の氏名および email アドレスを入力します。申請者側の全ての入力・電子署名が完了すると、経費支弁者の入力および電子署名ができるようになります。こちらで利用マニュアルを参考できます。

ステップ 2 以下の書類を準備する。

- 写真は申請者本人が正面を向いて映っており、顔がはっきりと確認できるものであれば、証明写真でなくても構いません。申請者以外の人が映り込んでいる写真は受け付けません。
- 正面を向き、帽子、マスク、サングラスなどを着用していない顔写真データを準備してください。
- 過去6ヶ月以内に撮影されたものを使用してください。
- 2) 言語運用能力を証明するスコアのコピー(データ)
- 申請条件に記載された英語運用能力を満たすスコアを提出してください。
- ウェブスコアを提出する場合は、必ず申請者の氏名、スコア、テスト取得日が確認できるページを提出してください。
- 英語が母語でない英語基準学生も英語スコアを提出する必要があります。
- アドミッションズ・オフィスでは、入学試験時に提出されたスコアの返却は行いません。
- 3) 【アメリカのパスポート保持者のみ】中学生以後(Grade 7以後)の学習歴を証明する書類 (データ)

アメリカのパスポート保持者は、中学校以降(Grade 7以降)の全ての成績証明書を提出する必要があります。在籍期間が成績証明書に記載されていない場合は、その学校に在籍した期間を証明する書類を別途提出する必要があります。学習歴を証明する書類が提出できない場合は、申請を受け付けません。

4) 【2025 年春入学生のみ】高校の成績証明書(英語で記載されたもの)(データ) 上記の 3)を提出された方は、こちらの4)を再度提出する必要ありません。

ステップ 3 上記のステップ2で準備された書類を Email にて提出してください。

5. 派遣内定者

内定者ガイダンス

内定者は全員、出発前までに実施されるすべてのガイダンスに必ず出席しなければなりません。さらに、合格者は SEU への出発前に危機管理ガイダンスに参加し、海外での心身の健康管理や危機管理について学びます。スケジュールや詳細は後日、内定者に連絡します。

6. 派遣内定後のプログラム参加取り消しについて

以下の条件全てを満たさない場合は、プログラムの参加が取り消しとなる場合があります。

派遣前

- 1) 3つの学修分野の入門レベルの科目を各 I 科目(合計 3 科目)履修済み、または修得予定。
- 2) 2025 年春セメスター終了時に通算 GPA が 3.00 以上であること。
- 3) 2025 年春セメスター終了時に、英語中級(日本語基準)または日本語必修(英語基準)の単位を修得もしくは免除されていること。
- 4) 指定された期日までに必要な書類(誓約書等)を全て提出すること。
- 5) SEU の 2025 年秋セメスター開始一週間前までに米国のビザを取得すること。

派遣後

- 1) 参加者は SEU での各セメスターにおいて以下 APU が定める最低修得単位数を修得すること。
- 2) SEU で通算 GPA を 2.00 以上で 維持すること。

However, credits from highly specialised courses will be recognized as credits from APS Major Subjects or Area of Study Major Subjects (IR, CSM, or GE).

<u>E. Global Studies Core Requirements</u>: credits from all courses in this category are recognized as credits from APS Major Subjects or Area of Study Major Subjects (IR, CSM, or GE).

Modern languages: credits from all Modern languages are recognized as Language Education Subjects at APU.

1. 基本姿勢

- (2) 立命館アジア太平洋大学(以下「本学」という。)の学生として自覚と誇りを持って、本学および派遣先大学・機関(以下「派遣先」という。) の名誉を傷つける行動は慎まなければならないこと。
- (3) プログラム期間中は、日本の法令および本学の諸規則の他、派遣先の国・地域の法令および諸規則を遵守し、本学および派遣先の教職員の指示に従わなければならないこと。
- (4) 派遣前後に行う事前/事後授業やガイダンスは必ず出席しなければならないこと。
- (5) プログラム申請をした時点で受講の意思があるものとして選考をされているため、選考結果発表後の辞退は認められないこと。
- (6) 遵守事項に反する事態を生じさせた場合は、本プログラムへの参加取消または帰国措置を命じられても、異議を申し立ててはならないこと。

2. 参加の取消・派遣の中止に関する事項

- (1) [全派遣プログラム(交換留学・ダブルディグリープログラム・キャンパスアジアプログラム・短期サマー/ウインタープログラム除く)] 参加に必要な提出物の提出、プログラム費の納付、パスポートおよび査証(ビザ)の取得、保険の加入等必要な手続きは本人が責任をもって指定期日までに行わなければならないこと。指定期日までに提出物の提出、プログラム費の納付、パスポートおよび査証(ビザ)の取得、保険の加入等必要手続きが完了しなかった場合は、いかなる理由であってもプログラムの参加が取り消されることを了承する。
- (2) [交換留学・ダブルディグリープログラム・キャンパスアジアプログラム・短期サマー/ウインタープログラム] 参加に必要な提出物の提出、プログラム費の納付、パスポートおよび査証(ビザ)の取得、保険の加入等必要な手続きは本人が責任をもって指定期日までに行わなければならないこと。指定期日までに提出物の提出、プログラム費の納付、パスポートおよび査証(ビザ)の取得、保険の加入等必要手続きが完了しなかった場合、参加取り消しをされる場合があることを了承する。
- (3) 上記に加え、以下のいずれかに該当する場合、合格発表後であっても、参加者のプログラム参加が取り消されることがあること。
 - A)参加態度、出席状況等を勘案し、受講不適当と判断された場合
 - B) 選考結果発表後、懲戒処分の対象となった場合
 - C) 負傷、病気等で留学が適当でないと本学が判断した場合
 - D) プログラム期間中の禁止行為を行った場合
 - E) プログラム所定の継続条件を満たさなかった場合
 - F)学籍を喪失した場合
 - G) その他学生としての本分に反した場合
- (4) 参加を取り消された場合、成績は「F」評価となる。(事前授業が開始される前に参加を取り消された場合は、「履修取消」となる)ことを 了承する。ただし、交換留学、ダブルディグリープログラム、キャパスアジアプログラムおよび短期サマー/ウインタープログラム除く。
- (5) 次に当てはまる場合は、本学の判断により学生派遣が中止されることを了承する。
 - A)派遣先国・地域こついての外務省の危険情報がレベル2以上である場合。 ただし、新たな感染症の蔓延等により、感染症危険情報が発令された場合は、状況に応じて判断する。
 - B)実習先での天災、災害、ストライキ、伝染病、現地情勢の変化、交通機関の運航状況、現地医療状況、戦争、テロ、引率者の怪我や急病及びそれに類する事象、危機発生時の派遣先機関における派遣学生への支援内容その他不可抗力に起因する事態が発生した場合。
 - C) 派遣先が、渡航を伴う APU からの学生受入中止を判断した場合

3. プログラム実施場所への集合・解散に関わる事項

[全海外派遣プログラム(FIRST、サービスラーニングを除く)]

- (1) プログラム期間中は現地集合および現地解散となることを了承し、行程中の安全確保も含め自己責任で行動すること。
- (2) 学生本人が航空券の手配を行い、本学が指定する期日までに旅程の提出を行うこと。
- (3) 予め本学に提出した旅程を理由なく変更しないこと。変更した場合は、変更した旅程を本学に提出すること。
- (4) プログラム参加のための渡航期間以外での行動は本学の責任ではなく、すべて参加者本人の責任において行動すること。

[FIRST、サービスラーニング]

- (1) プログラムは現地集合および解散は認められず、プログラム実施期間前に個人で入国してはならないこと。
- (2) プログラム実施期間終了後は、速やかに帰国しなければならないこと。派遣先国の滞在期間延長は、認められない。

4. 健康・安全管理に関する事項

- (1) [全海外派遣プログラム(FIRST、サービスラーニングを除く)] 渡航前に、日本出国および日本帰国までのすべての渡航期間について、本学が指定する海外旅行傷害保険に加入すること。また、本学が指定する期間について、危機管理支援システムに加入すること。 [FIRST、サービスラーニング]渡航前に、本学が指定する海外旅行傷害保険および危機管理支援システムに加入すること。 [国内プログラムの場合]本学が指定する国内旅行傷害保険へ加入すること。
- (2) 健康管理は、自らの責任で行うこと。また、健康状況および学修支援の要否を所定の書式にて申告すること。
- (3) 既往症等がある場合は、申し出ること。
- (4) 傷病等により入院加療の医療措置が必要となった場合は、すみやかに本学および派遣先に報告するとともに教職員の指示に従うこと。

- ただし、これらの措置に必要な費用の内、保険の補償限度額超過分については、本人が負担すること。
- (5) 緊急に医療手当または手術の必要が生じ、本人または保証人の同意を得る時間的猶予がない場合は、本学もしくは派遣先の教職員または医師の判断によって処置することに同意すること。

- (4) 万一、査証(ビザ)が取得できない場合は、派遣または留学は取り消しとなること。また、査証(ビザ)が取得できなかったことを理由として、派遣または留学開始時期の変更等は行わない。
