Admission Procedure

Application is completed through UGM online application system: admission.ugm.ac.id/registration/

Application Materials:

- 1. Curriculum Vitae
- 2. Scanned copy of passport (ID page; passport must be valid until 6 months after period of study in Indonesia)
- 3. Scanned copy of passport cover
- 4. Statement of financial support (template is available on admission system)
- 5. Personal statement (*template is available on admission system*)
- 6. Recommendation/Nomination letter from applicants' home university/institution
- 7. Copy of academic record
- 8. Statement of good health
- 9. Passport-sized photograph (*red background*)
- 10. English language proficiency certificate

During the pandemic, the Government of the Republic of Indonesia has set a regulation to request a few more documents for visa application. The students do not have to prepare the following documents during the application period in our admission system. However, once the



Study Permit is issued by the Ministry of Education and Culture, we will contact the students to send the following documents.

We hope the students could expect and prepare the documents in advance so the process of visa application could go smoothly. The additional documents deeded for visa application during the pandemic are as follows:

- 1. Legal proof of full vaccine dose completion (2 dosages; except Janssen Vaccines or other types of vaccine that only have one dosage; in English)
- 2. Additional Statement Letter for Visa Application (template provided)
- 3. Proof that the students hold international health insurance (in English)

Language Requirements

Language of instruction at Universitas Gadjah Mada is mainly Bahasa Indonesia. However, international programs are taught in English. Specification on language requirements can be part of interinstitutional agreement. However, the general requirement is as follows:

TOEFL:550 (paper-based); IELTS: no less than 5.5; iBT: minimum 70

| | As per December 2021, there are a few payment details that shall be completed by international students namely e-Visa, Visa Authorization, Limited Stay Permit (ITAS) and Multiple Exit Re-Entry Permit (MERP), and Administration Fee. The e-Visa is billed in USD by the Government, therefore the exact amount depends on the day of the Letter of Offer issuance. Therefore, we could only give the approximate amount of fee that will be billed to students: |
