# In what languages courses are taught at ISC Paris?

At ISC Paris, you can study in French and in English.

# What language level is required to come and study at ISC Paris?

- TOEFL IBT test minimum score: 79/120 points
- **OTOEFL ITP** test minimum score: 543/677 points
- **TOEIC** test minimum score: 785/990 points
- o **IELTS** test minimum score: 6.5 points
- Duolingo test minimum score: 90 points
- o Cambridge minimum score: B2
- **CEFR** (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, for students who wish to take course taught in French): minimum score B2

Please note that we only accept proficiency documents submitted in English. The English test must have been taken within 2 years of the result date.

# Transcript of records

Transcripts will be available on the student's ISC intranet account, and will be sent to home institution coordinators too.

# Do you offer a language course for incoming students and what are the costs? Can students obtain ECTS?

FLE (French as a second language) is mandatory for all exchange students. The course is worth 2 ECTS. Additionally, students can enroll in one online language course (2 ECTS).

# What is the minimum workload required?

The minimum workload required is 15 ECTS, which corresponds to 5 to 6 courses.


