No entry clearance required; show your UK passport on entry (except BNO passport holders, who will require prior entry clearance)

Medical cover

Is the purchase of university or state health insurance required?

For students studying with us for just one semester:

No health insurance provided. We strongly recommend students to purchase their own health insurance prior to arriving at Herts.

For students studying with us for a full year:

You will have access to the NHS (National Health Service). If a student stays for over six months, there is a health service charge in the VISA process.

The NHS Surcharge will grant the VISA holder access to free health services in the UK. See link below for more information:
