Institutional overview	<p>Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU) is a unique Higher Education institution located in Suzhou, Jiangsu Province, China. It is the largest international collaborative university in China established in 2006 by its parent institutions, the University of Liverpool (UK) and Xi'an Jiaotong University (China).</p> <p>XJTLU is an independent University with degree awarding powers under the Chinese Ministry of Education. XJTLU enrolls Chinese students through the "Gaokao" national examination system (tier 1 students) and international students through independent admissions. XJTLU is situated on a purpose built campus in the Dushu Lake Higher Education Town at the heart of one of Asia's research and innovation hubs. Markers of XJTLU's quality can be seen through the high rankings of both of parent Universities; both nationally and internationally well regarded.</p>

* Taicang Campus	<i>Please notice that we have another campus which is in Taicang (1.5 hours' drive one-way from main campus). This campus has major related to Data/AI/Microelectronic Science/Manufacturing/ Robotics/Supply chain and so on, students normally cannot select Taicang campus courses as transportation between two campuses are impossible, unless you choose all your modules/courses only in Taicang. Taicang currently does not offer Chinese Language and China Studies related modules.</i>

Undergraduate degree structure	Degree courses are 4 years with a general education in Year 1. Degree specific content is taught according to the 3-year UK norm in Years 2, 3 and 4.

STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

HET student accommodation is owned by Dushu Lake Higher Education Town where XJTLU is located. XJTLU doesn't own the property, but can reserve accommodations for students. Price varies from RMB 2000-3800 monthly.

Utilities	Utilities include electricity and water. Bills is run on a pay-as you-go system. Students should top up at the reception desk.

ESTIMATED EXPENSES

Generally, students should plan for USD 600-1200 monthly for living expense, depends on your consumption capacity:

- Non-refundable service charge RMB 300 per semester (ID card, insurance and logistical costs of induction processes)
- Accommodation & Utilities
- Food
- Telephone
- Transport
- Medical costs
- Visa/Residence Permit costs
- Etc.

HEALTH AND INSURANCE

Public hospitals and insurance	<p>The medical insurance provided by XJTLU covers treatment in public hospitals. Public hospitals in Suzhou are generally clean and reliable. Due to language barrier and different registration procedures in hospitals, students are advised to take a Chinese speaker with them when they go. If required Global Team at XJTLU can arrange a staff member or a student volunteer to assist international students.</p> <p>Student need to keep all the receipts/invoices and paperwork related to the hospital visit in order to claim back the expenses, either against their own insurance or the one provided by XJTLU.</p>
Private clinics	<p>Private clinics are more foreigner-friendly. Doctors are generally either international or have a high standard of English. Treatment is entirely western medicine based. Private clinics are significantly more expensive than public hospitals. The insurance provided by XJTLU does not cover private clinics.</p>
Dentists services	<p>There is a dental clinic close to XJTLU campus. All major hospitals provide dentist services. The insurance provided by XJTLU does not cover dental treatments.</p>
Pharmacy	<p>There are several pharmacies near XJTLU campus, both within 15 minutes' walk from campus. The pharmacies provide a range of Western and Chinese medicines. Staff don't speak English, so students should have the name of the medicine written in Chinese, or take a Chinese friend when they go. Students should always check the chemical name on the information sheet inside the box. Certain medicines may only be available in major hospitals or private clinics.</p>

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Appendix: Requirement of Admission

(1) Academic

Participating students shall be selected by your home institution, usually based on academic merit and suitability, and are subject to acceptance by Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (hereafter XJTLU) undertaking the normal admission procedures.

Students who nominated by home country are required to achieve the score in the following. Please notice that even in the same country, universities or institutions might have different marking system. Listed is just the one mainly inside the country.

The required score for a personal student sometimes will be higher or lower, depending on students' different education background.

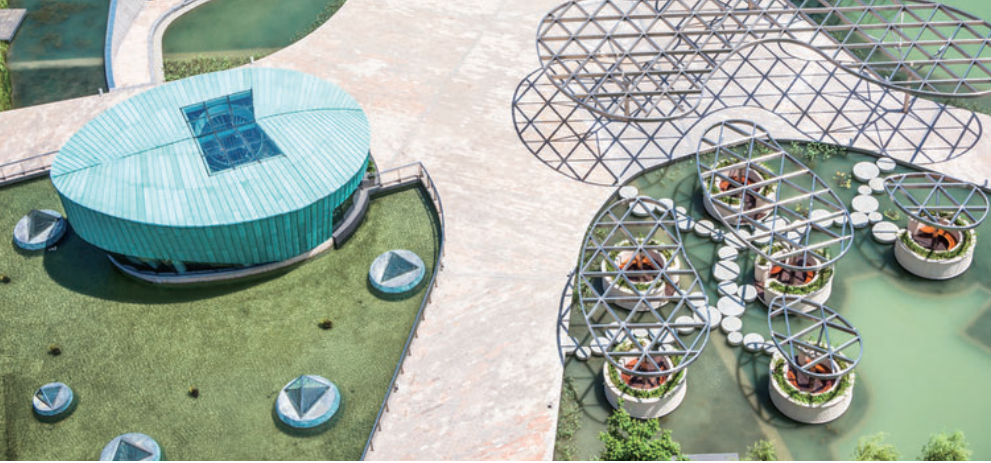
(2) English

English is the language of instruction at XJTLU. Applicants for any undergraduate or postgraduate course of study, including Exchange/Visiting Students, whose first language is not English, should include an original or certified true copy of international English Certificate, such as:

CEFR		B2+/C1
1	IELTS	6.5
2	Pearson Test of English (PTE)	62
3	TOEFL (IBT)	90
4	Cambridge English Levels FCE/CAE/CPE	CEFR B2+, score 173 or above

You are exempted from proving your English proficiency when:

- Students who are nationals or who have previously completed an academic qualification equivalent to China High School degree, from a majority English-speaking country are automatically assumed to meet minimum English language requirements. These countries are: Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Canada, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Jamaica, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom and the United States of America
- Please submit an English proficiency letter issued by your home university Language Centre (or equivalent unit) to proof you are in CEFR B2+ Level.
- Any other international English Certificate which XJTLU recognizes.

XJTLU makes China accessible for international exchange students no matter your study interest. Module Selection:

Students normally study 20 credits per semester. Choose your modules (also known as classes or courses at other universities) in order of preference when you submit your selections to XJTLU. Your module selections should be approved by your home university before you submit them to XJTLU.

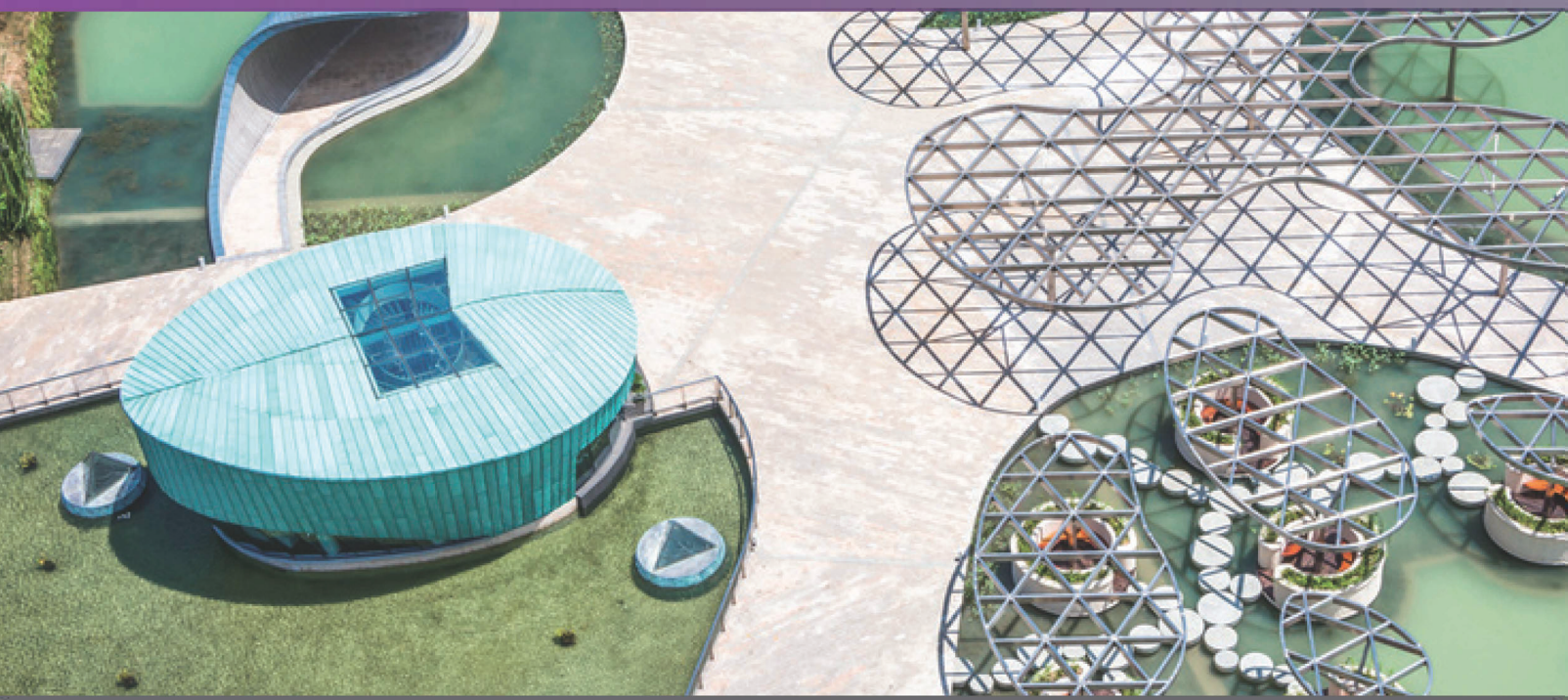
