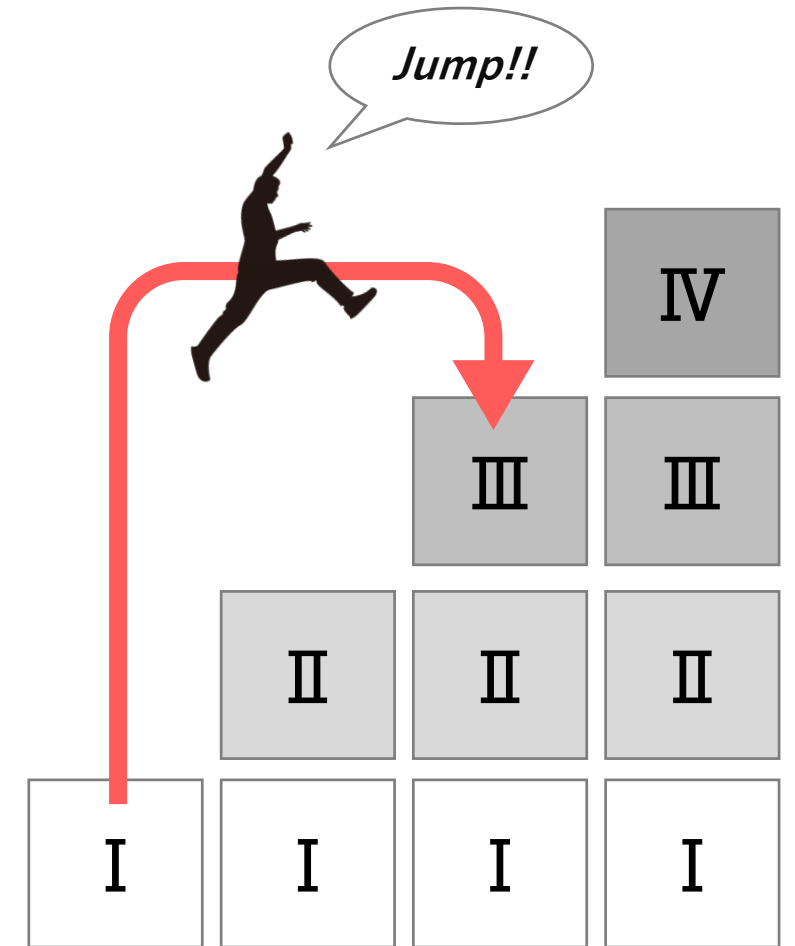
The announcement will be posted on Campus Terminal during the period below
