Issuance of Student ID Card, Address Registration and Opening a Japan Post Bank Account

We will issue your Student ID Card, carry out address registration and support you to open your Japan Post bank account at classroom F104 at the following date and time.

APM →Monday, September 28 from 9:00 am

Graduate School →Tuesday, September 29 from 9:00am

APS→Tuesday, September 29 from 11:00am

ST→Tuesday, September 29 from 3:00pm

<Things you need to bring on the day>

- ①Passport
- ②Residence card
- ③A device which you can check your e-mail
- ④A screenshot of the screen showing your student ID number as notified through the enrollment procedure system
- ⑤Housing contract to confirm your address in Beppu

<Opening of Japan Post Bank Account>

If you would like to open a “Yucho (Japan Post Bank) Direct + (Plus) Account (hereinafter called “Yucho Bank account”)”, we will support you at AP House Office 2 every Wednesday in October.

You will need “Yucho Bank account” to receive scholarship, pay tuition fee, as well as to make any other transactions for your everyday life such as receiving your part time payment and paying for electricity bills, etc.

If you would like to open the “Yucho Bank account”, please read the following instructions carefully and come to AP House Office 2.

Step① "Answer the survey for Opening a Yucho Bank account" [Deadline: September 27 (Sun), 11:59pm].
