Short-term, intensive language study programs held during summer and winter break.

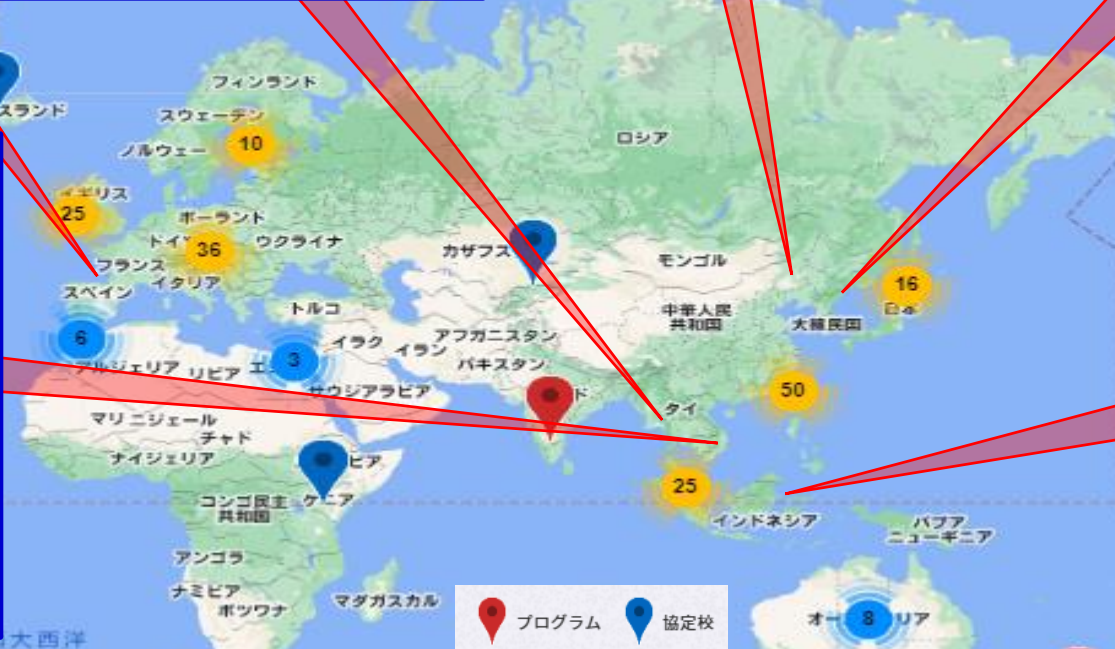
